## Anti-Slavery Policy Statement

Section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 requires commercial organisations carrying out business in the UK, with a turnover of at least £36 million, to prepare and publish a slavery and human trafficking statement for each and every financial year. m&h does not fall under these requirements but are committed to upholding the principal of ethical business practices and the implementation of practices to combat modern slavery.

m&h take a zero-tolerance approach to modern slavery and strictly prohibit the use of forced labour and human trafficking in all our direct operations and the indirect operations of our supply chain. m&h is committed to maintaining and improving systems & processes to avoid complicity in human rights violations related to our own operations and those of our supply chain.

Our supply chain includes companies supplying materials and products, supply & fix contracts and professional services across a portfolio of construction projects we deliver for clients. m&h operates a preferred supplier database and conducts due diligence on all suppliers before allowing them to become an approved contractor.

- As part of our contractor assessment, we acknowledge our support of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and compliance thereof.
- We will only trade with those who have appropriate controls in place to comply with the Act and may terminate the contract at any time, should any instances of slavery and human trafficking become apparent.

In m&h we foster a culture of ethical & social values where all employees are informed and facilitated to conduct themselves in accordance with the highest ethical standards. All m&h employees are provided with instruction and training in human rights & modern slavery.

We committed to working in partnership with our clients, community stakeholders and supply chain in a sustainable way that enables us to find more practical and safer methods of ethical trading free from slavery and human trafficking.
